Here's a list of exterior tasks volunteers can complete w/their own tools & supplies. Water can be taken from the hose near the west entrance.

Trash & debris pickup around the property (ongoing)

Gloves, trash bag for debris

Sweep up asphalt and dirt that accumulates at the curb across from front entrance (twice a year, spring and fall)

Broom, shovel, trash bag for debris

Sweep pine needles & debris from driveway curb, clean debris from storm drain at the entrance of the driveway (twice a year, spring and fall)

Broom, shovel, trash bag for debris

Sweep sidewalks, cement pads and entrances and remove debris if necessary (ongoing)

Broom, shovel, trash bag for debris

East entrance near office

West entrance & bike rack area near parking lot

Cement pad adjacent to middle school classroom (east side of bldg)

Clean wooden benches at east and west entrances

Bucket, sponge, wood soap

Wash & dry windows

Ladder, bucket, white vinegar, wash rags or squeegee, drying towels

Scrub exterior walls to remove mold

Ladder, bucket, gloves, protective eyewear, scrubbing brush, Jomax, bleach (recipe: 80% water, 15% bleach, and 5% Jomax)

Planting flowers

Flowers, potting soil, gloves, kneeler, hand spade, water can

Weeding (late April/early May):

Kneeler, bucket or trash bag for debris, hand spade or dandelion digger

Flower beds along the south-facing wall in front of classrooms

Lava rock beds at the church entrance

Flower beds along the south-facing wall in front of the nursery & bathrooms

Lillies in rock bed by the water hose

Flower garden in front of Fellowship Hall

Rock beds in parking lot

Rock beds behind Fellowship Hall and long north facing wall

Flower beds along east facing wall (looking at Chapel Valley Rd)

Flower bed at base of white cross

Island of arbor vitae along Chapel Valley Rd

Church sign along Chapel Valley Rd (05/11/2020, In-process Darla)

Trimming (with string trimmer): *trimmer, gloves, protective eyewear, blower for debris*

Pine tree beds between the church and McKee Farms Park Apartments

Island of arbor vitae along Chapel Valley Rd

Curbs around rock beds in parking lot

Large cracks around parking lot

Sidewalk running along McKee Rd

Under church sign along McKee Rd

Under shrubs along south-facing wall

Mulching: mulch, shovel, wheel barrel, gloves, kneeler

Flower beds along the south-facing wall

Flower garden in front of Fellowship Hall

Flower beds along east facing wall (looking at Chapel Valley Rd)

Church sign along Chapel Valley Rd

Pine trees between the McKee Farms Park Apartments

Pruning/Trimming trees & shrubs: *lopper, pruning shears, gloves, buckets or trash bags for removing debris*

Shrubs along south-facing wall

Shrubs along the north-facing wall

All flowering trees along the perimeter of the building

Applying Preen (weed killer) to rock beds (done, early May 2020)

Applying systemic to birch trees to repel Asian beetles

Attention needed around play structure:

- Cutting the broken pipe from the base (done)
- Fixing / permanently disposing of the broken picnic table sharp, wooden ends are exposed (sharp wood was cut away and table was repositioned on pea gravel near the garden for gardeners to have seating)
- Checking the play structure for strength and sturdiness (the structure is sturdy / the slides have thick cuts in the plastic we should look into fixing)
- Checking the play structure for bee/wasp nests and clearing them away (didn't see any nests as of 5/9/2020)
- Cleaning the play structure of dirt and debris (looks good)
- Make a plan to repaint this summer?
