Called to Know Jesus...(Worship Info)

Combined Worship, Sunday, September 11, 2022 - 9:00 a.m.

This Sunday is the fourteenth Sunday after Pentecost. *"The grumbling of the religious leaders in today's gospel is actually our holy hope: This Jesus welcomes sinners and eats with them. That our God seeks and saves the lost is not only a holy hope, it is our only hope. As the writer of 1 Timothy reminds us, "The saying is sure and worthy of full acceptance, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners." Thanks be to God."* (sundaysandseasons.com) The scriptures that shape our worship on Sunday are: Exodus 32:7-14, Psalm 51:1-10, 1 Timothy 1:12-17 and Luke 15:1-10. We share in the meal of Holy Communion each Sunday morning. If you are gathered in person, you will receive a wafer and an individual cup of wine or grape juice. If you are worshipping from home, you will want to have bread or crackers and wine or juice available in order to participate in the meal.

Bibles and Books Needed for Residents of the Dane County Jail

The Madison Area Jail Ministry (MAJM) collects Bibles and Christian books to help meet the spiritual needs of Dane County Jail residents who do not have the access we do to these resources. Our donations can ensure that jail residents receive a Bible or have more Christian books available in the current limited library. Some information as you select your donations:

- a) Hard covers are not accepted, only soft cover or paperback.
- b) Only the Bibles listed are accepted. The chaplains want to ensure that there is uniformity in the Bible each resident receives. .
- c) The Amazon Wish List has prices listed and an address to which the donations can be sent.
- d) If you prefer to have books from the Amazon Wish List sent to you directly, bring the books to church and place them in the bin in the fellowship hall.
- e) You can also donate your own used and in good condition Christian books which should be soft cover or paperback. Those also can be placed in the container at church.

Thank you for your caring and generosity which will make a difference in the spiritual lives of jail residents.
